

Constitutional Amendment:

Pro-rating of dues question

Existing:

Section 2.09 Dues. The Board, at each annual meeting, shall determine the membership dues for the Association for the ensuing year. Dues are for the calendar year and are payable January 1st and are delinquent after 90 days. Dues for persons joining during the year will be prorated for that year (to the nearest dollar) from the beginning of the next month following their admission.

- 1.) Regular Members: \$ 36.00 per year
- 2.) Entity Members \$100.00 per year
- 3.) Life Member \$500.00 Donation
- 4.] Corporate Life Member \$10,000 Donation

Changed to:

Section 2.09 Dues. The Board, at each annual meeting, shall determine the membership dues for the Association for the ensuing year. Dues are for the calendar year and are payable January 1st and are delinquent after 90 days. Dues are prorated for new members but not prorated for persons that were ever a member. **(Board vote 10/1/06)**

Added:

a) Initial dues for the ensuing year are:

1.) Renewing Members (persons that have ever been a member: \$ 36.00 per year, non-prorated regardless of renewal date.

1a) New Members: Prorated at \$3 per month but never less than \$18

- 2.) Entity Members \$100.00 per year
- 3.) Life Member \$500.00 Donation
- 4.] Corporate Life Member \$10,000 Donation
